Supply List

- Lion Brand Pound of Love 350 yds. Or Bernat Baby Sport 260 yds (each skein will make 2 full sets for baby size 1-3lbs)
 - Any Color
- 5.5mm (I/9) hook
- 6.0 mm (J/10) hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle to weave in ends

Stitches/ Abbreviations used US terminology:

- CH = Chain Stitch
- SC = Single Crochet
- DC = Double Crochet
- FPDC = Front Post Double Crochet
- SDC = Standing Double Crochet
- S = Slip Stitch
- St = Stitch

Note: 1.)Lion brand Pound of love will be represented by the color black in the st count and Bernat Baby Sport will be in represented as follows (# sts)

2.) Instead of a CH3 at the beginning of a DC row make a standing DC Crochet example shown on

3.) Finished size 18" x 20"

To start use 6mm hook (J/10): CH 56 (60) and turn

Row 1: SC in second ch from hook, Insert hook into the same sp as SC st and pull up a loop, pull up a loop from the next 2 sts, now you should have 4 loops on your hook, yo and pull through all loops on your hook, CH to close. (insert hook into same sp and pull up a loop, pull up a loop from the next 2 sts, yo and pull through all loops on hook chi to close)* repeat across, on the last one don't close with CH do a sc into the last st.

Row 2: CH and turn, 1 sc into first st, (insert hook into same sp and pull up a loop, pull up a loop from the next 2 sts, yo and pull through all loops on hook chi to close)* repeat across, on the last one don't close with CH do a SC into the last st.

Repeat row 2 till you reach 17.5" in length {For me it was 55 rows (57 rows)} do not fasten off.

Border Alpine Stitch:

Change to 5.5 (I/9) mm hook.

Round 1:

- *First side:* SDC and turn, DC in the same st, 1 DC in each st across, DC 2in the last st . For the corner CH 2 and DC 2 into same space as last 2 DCs.{57 sts (61 sts)}
- *Second side:* 1 DC in each row. For the corner CH 2 and DC 2 into same space as last 2 DCs {55 sts (59 sts)}
- *Third side:* 1 DC in every CH across, DC 2 in the last CH. For the corner CH 2 and DC 2 into same space as last 2 DCs.{57 sts (61 sts)}

- *Fourth side:* 1 DC in each row. For the corner CH 1, SC into the top of the SDC {55 sts (59 sts)}

Round 2:

- *First side:* SC around the SC you just made, make a SDC in the same space, FPDC around the first DC, DC into the next st. (FPDC around the next st, DC into the next st)* repeat until you reach the corner, DC into the CH 2 space, CH 2, DC 1 into the same space. {59 sts (63 sts)}
- *Second side:* FPDC around the first DC on this side, DC into the next st. (FPDC around the next st, DC into the next st)* repeat until you reach the corner, DC into the CH 2 space, CH 2, DC 1 into the same space. {57 sts (61 sts)}
- *Third side:* FPDC around the first DC on this side, DC into the next st. (FPDC around the next st, DC into the next st)* repeat until you reach the corner, DC into the CH 2 space, CH 2, DC 1 into the same space. {59 sts (63 sts)}
- *Forth side:* FPDC around the first DC on this side, DC into the next st. (FPDC around the next st, DC into the next st)* repeat until you reach the corner, DC into the CH 2 space. For the corner CH 1, SC into the top of the SDC. {57 sts (61 sts)}

Round 3-4: repeat round 2

- *Round 4 end:* CH 2, SC into the top of the SDC

Round 5: SC in the remaining sts completely around your blanket, SC 3 across the CH 2 spaces. Finish off.

Sew in ends and your Angel baby blanket is complete and ready to donate!
